STATE OF EMERGENCY WAS DECLARED FOR 12 DAYS IN PARIS SINCE THE TERRORIST ATTACKS

BLACK FRIDAY OF NOVEMBER 13TH

USPA NEWS - The state of emergency has been decreed for 12 days and 3 days of national mourning by President Hollande. François Molins, the prosecutor of Paris announced that "Eight terrorists were neutralised" [?].

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The Paris prosecutor's office opened an investigation for murder in connection with a terrorist enterprise.

A large number of witnesses were taken to the Centre of Criminal Police as the information flows and more and more details are preceded by the time, in order to identify who are the attackers and if remains any other criminal fugitives, by the investigators.

The Prefecture of Paris has set up some specific and strict measures at the attention of the Parisians. They asks Parisians not to go out unless you have a reason and announced the closure of schools and universities Saturday, and all the amenities of the city of Paris: schools, libraries, gyms, swimming pools, food markets. School trips are canceled. Normally schools will reopen on Monday has announced the interior minister, Bernard Cazeneuve.
